

Day 2: Lima Tuesday, February 17th

Breakfast at the hotel. Welcome to Peru! Upon arrival, you will be privately transferred to your accommodation where you have early check in access to rest. This afternoon, enjoy a City Tour of Lima. We will begin this afternoon with the visit of the city with an exploration of Colonial Lima visiting the Main Square, to explore it on foot and admire the exteriors of the Government Palace, the Cathedral, and the City Hall, all examples of Lima's still present colonial architectural opulence. Then, we will visit Casa Aliaga, a colonial mansion that currently holds the distinction of being the oldest continuously inhabited private residence in the Southern Hemisphere. Next, we will make our way to Santo Domingo Convent a religious and architectural gem that houses holy paintings, images, and relics of Peruvian saints, as well as written accounts of the endeavors of the Dominican Order across the country. Afterwards, we will head to Larco Museum, an eighteenth century Viceregal mansion that houses more than 3,000 years of Peru's pre-Columbian history. The museum boasts a supremely fine collection of gold and silver jewelry and worship paraphernalia. Return to your hotel for a Welcome dinner in Café del Museo.

Day 3: Lima – Cusco - Sacred Valley Wednesday, February 18th

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning, you will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Cusco. Arrival at Cusco Airport, and transfer to your hotel in the Sacred Valley. On the way we will visit Manos de la Comunidad Center. Here, we will learn about the various types of camelids (Llamas, Alpacas, Vicuñas, and Guanacos) that live in the Andes region. Additionally, the local villagers will teach us about the ancestral methods and techniques used to produce their textile art. We will make a stop for lunch at Hacienda Sarapampa. Discover the legacy of three generations of one of the most traditional families of the Sacred Valley. Learn about the generational experiences and the work that lies behind production of Cusco's giant white corn, a unique species that only grows in this area. And finally, enjoy a unique experience in the form of traditional cooking based upon local organic products, the legacy of farmers devoted to their land. Continue to your hotel for overnight.

Day 4: Sacred Valley – Machu Picchu – Sacred Valley Thursday, February 19th

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you will be privately transferred to the train station. Board the train for your journey to Machu Picchu. The comfortable train ride from there to the station at Aguas Calientes is packed full of spectacular vistas. Vistadome Train from Ollantaytambo to Machu Picchu – 08:00-09:25 Upon arrival, you will be transferred to the entrance of the citadel to start your amazing journey for your full day visit to the Historic Sanctuary of Machu Picchu. Unearthed for modernity by Hiram Bingham more than a century ago, Machu Picchu is considered one of the seven wonders of the world. Its architectural beauty, spectacular natural setting, and the energy that radiates from its enigmatic buildings will take your breath away. We will follow in the footsteps of the ancient Incas as we take a tour of the magical citadel led by one of our guides. Afterwards you will enjoy a delicious lunch at Tinkuy Restaurant. Finally, we will return to Aguas Calientes train station to board your return train to Ollanta Station. Vistadome Train from Machu Picchu to Ollantaytambo -16:43-18:31. Upon arrival at Ollanta rail station, you will be met by our representative who will transfer you to your hotel in the Sacred Valley.
